What is the CMTS?

- 46 U.S.C. 55502(b), The CMTS shall serve as a federal interagency coordinating committee for the purpose of:
 - Assessing the adequacy of the MTS
 - Promoting integration of the MTS with other modes of transportation and other uses of the marine environment
 - Coordinating, improving the coordination of, and making recommendations with regard to federal policies that impact the MTS
 - Chartered in 2005 in response to Presidential Directive (charter being updated)
 - 28+ Departments, independent agencies and WH offices
 - SECDOT Chair
