
Aquaculture

Pond 20 – Conceptual Restoration Plan

- Wetlands Mitigation Bank
 - 95 acres
 - Create tidal wetlands
- Otay River Estuary Restoration Project -USFWS & Poseidon Resources





Design Components and Construction Sequence

- Site excavation to marsh elevations
- Excavate tidal channels
- Transition zone/upland grading
- Berm breach construction
- Soil/sediment preparation and planting
- Poseidon Fall 2020
- Port Spring/Summer
 2021





Excavation

- 550,000 cy of material
- Soil analyses completed
- Disposal site(s) still to be determined
 - Chula Vista Bayfront Redevelopment Project
 - San Diego Bay National Wildlife Refuge
 - Private entities



Previous redevelopment project in South Bay located north east of Pond 20



Otay River Estuary Restoration Project

- Mitigation for Poseidon Water Resources Desalination Facility
- To the North and East of Pond 20 Site
- Requires coordination between both projects

- ✓ Soil Management Planning
- Environmental Review Initiated
- ✓ USFWS/Poseidon Coordination






Next Steps
