## **Port of Lake Charles**

A Strategic Energy Port of National Importance

- 12<sup>th</sup> largest U.S. port based on tonnage
- 56.5 million tons of cargo annually
- 85% of the Port's tonnage is energy cargo
- 2nd Largest U.S. Strategic Petroleum Reserve Facility
- 3 Refineries on the Ship Channel
- Located at the Center of the U.S. Pipeline Infrastructure and on the Colonial Pipeline serving the northeast U.S
- Approximately 1,000 deep draft vessels annually
- \$800 million annually in payments into the federal treasury (income tax, Customs collections, HMTF tax, etc.)

- \$88.5+ Billion In Current (under construction) or Announced Channel Dependent Projects
  - 25,100 construction jobs
  - 19,000 permanent jobs (Direct, Indirect and Induced)
    - Cameron LNG
    - Sasol
    - Lake Charles LNG
    - Lotte Westlake Chemical Complex
    - Big Lake Fuels/G2X
    - Magnolia LNG
    - Venture Global LNG
- Expected to increase current annual federal revenue from \$800 million to nearly \$1.1 billion per year
- Approximately 2,000 deep draft vessels annually

#### **Cameron LNG**

- \$10 billion capital investment.
- Permitted by FERC to export up to 14.95 mtpa of LNG.
- Train 1 began commercial operations in August, 2019.
- Trains 2 and 3 should be operational shortly.
- Cameron LNG has began the approval process to add two liquefaction trains.
- If approved, Cameron LNG's export capacity will be 24.92 mtpa or 3.53 bcfd (billion cubic feet per day).

#### **Venture Global LNG**

- 12.0 mtpa LNG export facility.
- Construction on the \$4.25 billion project has begun.
- 130 permanent operations jobs.
- 1,500 construction jobs.

#### Lake Charles LNG

- 3 trains producing up to 16.45 mtpa.
- \$10 billion project is a joint venture of Shell and Energy Transfer.
- FERC authorization received 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2015.
- 200 permanent jobs.
- 5,000 construction jobs.

#### Magnolia LNG

- 8 mtpa LNG facility
- \$3.35 billion capital investment
- Approximately 70 permanent employees
- Approximately 1,000 construction jobs

#### **Driftwood LNG**

- 27.6 mtpa LNG export facility.
- Approximately \$15-20 billion capital investment (based on the cost of other LNG facilities).
- 250 permanent jobs.
- 3,500 construction jobs.

#### Westlake/Lotte Chemical

- Joint Venture between Westlake Chemical and Lotte totaling \$3 billion.
- Ethane cracker and monoethylene glycol manufacturing facilities adjacent to one another.
- Will produce two billion pounds of ethylene per year.
- 215 permanent jobs.
- 2,000 construction jobs.

- Natural gas to methanol plant.
- Will produce 1.4 million mtpa of methanol.
- \$1.6 billion capital investment
- 150 permanent jobs
- 2500 construction jobs

## **Keeping the Channel Open**


#### Current Dredging

- Approximately half of the inner Channel is dredged every other year.
- Dredged material is typically placed in upland disposal sites.
- Bar channel is dredged every year (hopper dredge).
- Typical O&M is \$30-40 million annually.

#### Future????

 Channel users would like to explore the possibility of dredging most of the channel every year.

## **Dredging the Channel Every Year**

#### Increased Costs

Corps' O&M budget would have to be increased to \$60-70 million/year.

#### Additional Disposal Capacity

- Disposal Capacity is limited already.
- Port of Lake Charles bears 100% of the real estate costs and 25% of the construction cost.
