
Career Advising

OVERARCHING & POST-SECONDARY GOALS

By end of Sophomore year, 100% of rising seniors will select a pathway in either maritime or aviation.

93% of all high school seniors will graduate high school within 4 years.

Post-graduation, 80% of students will enter a post-secondary education program, apprenticeship, service, or right-to-work training program.

Of these graduates, a minimum of 70% will select a postsecondary option in alignment with a maritime or aviation pathway.





GROWING IMPACT

Strengthened funding support in the past 2 years, growing resources by \$1.4 million and stabilized year over year expenses

Jetsam Flotsam Crew collected over 292,000 pounds of floating debris in 2023

81% Freshmen completed the 9th grade maritime immersion experience (12% increase over prior year)

83% High School Graduation Rate (in 4 years)

In 2023, over 91 8th grade students selected Davis A&M High School as their firstchoice school during first round selections 400% increase in number of students Impacted (in past 5 years)

375% increase in # of work training opportunities in 2 years
